1998-2008**

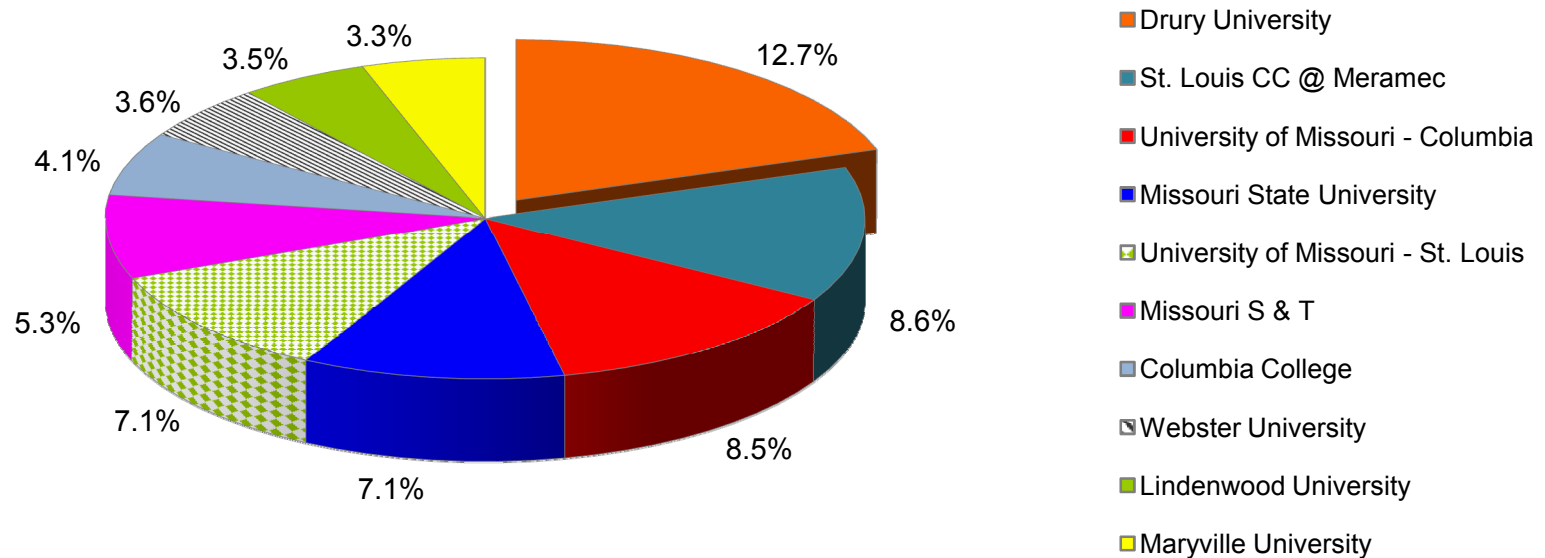
