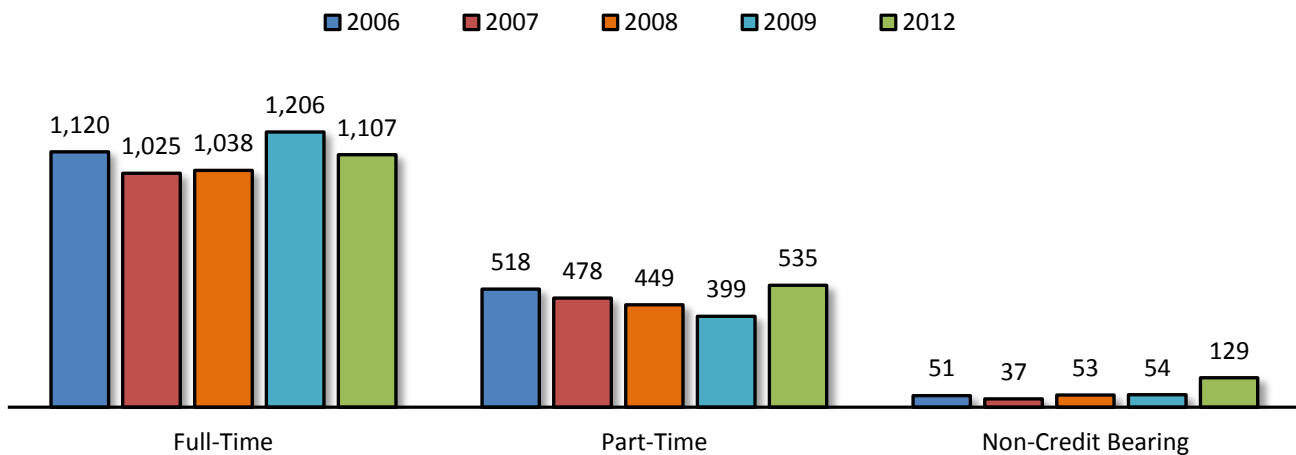

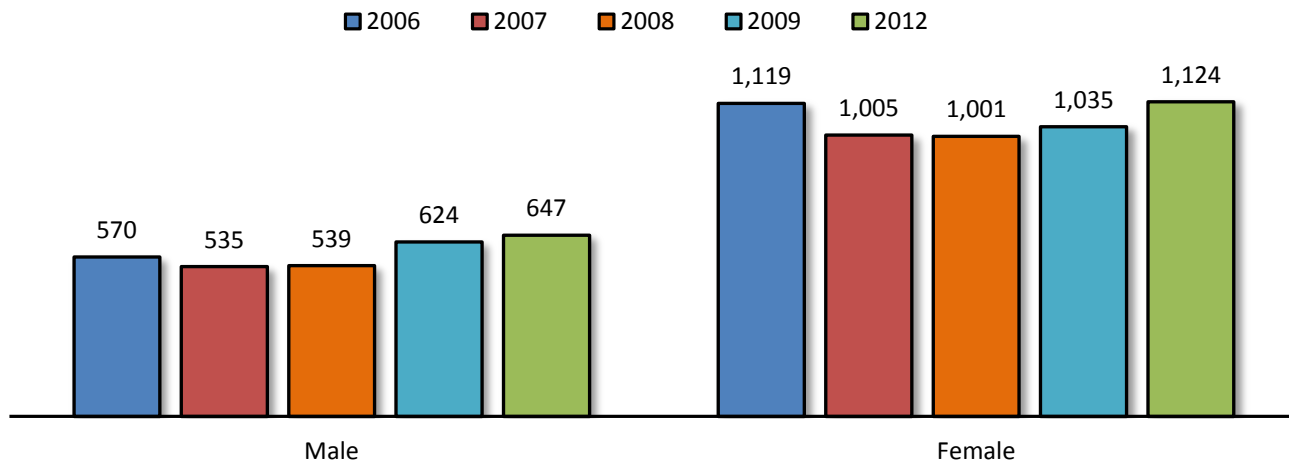

Visitors by Gender



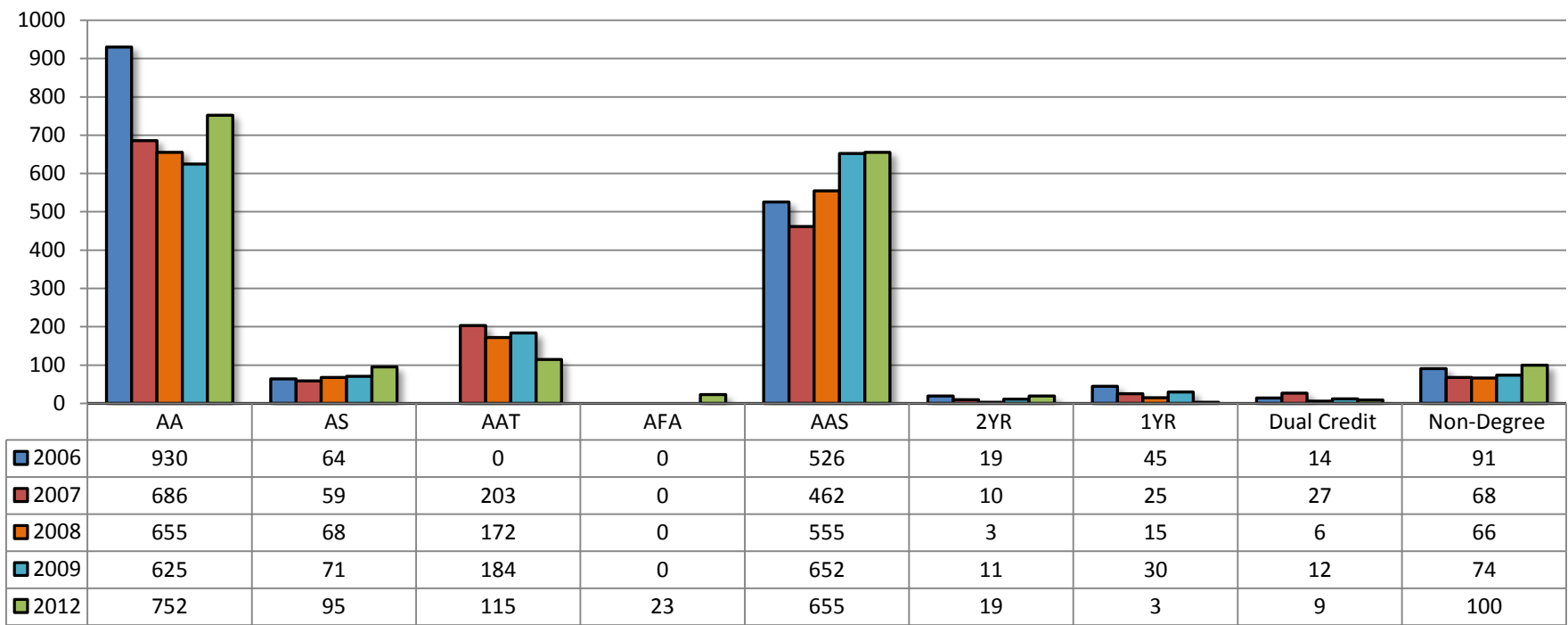

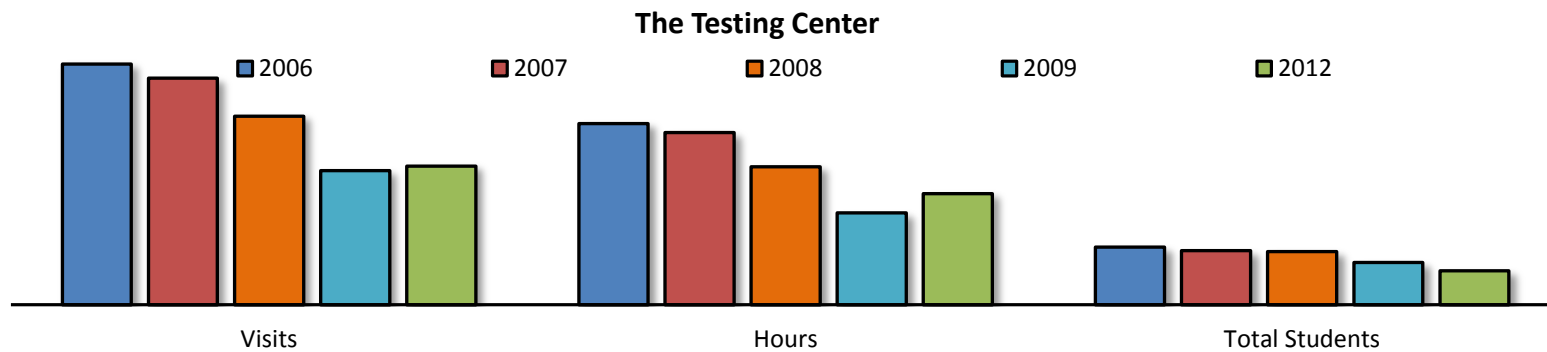
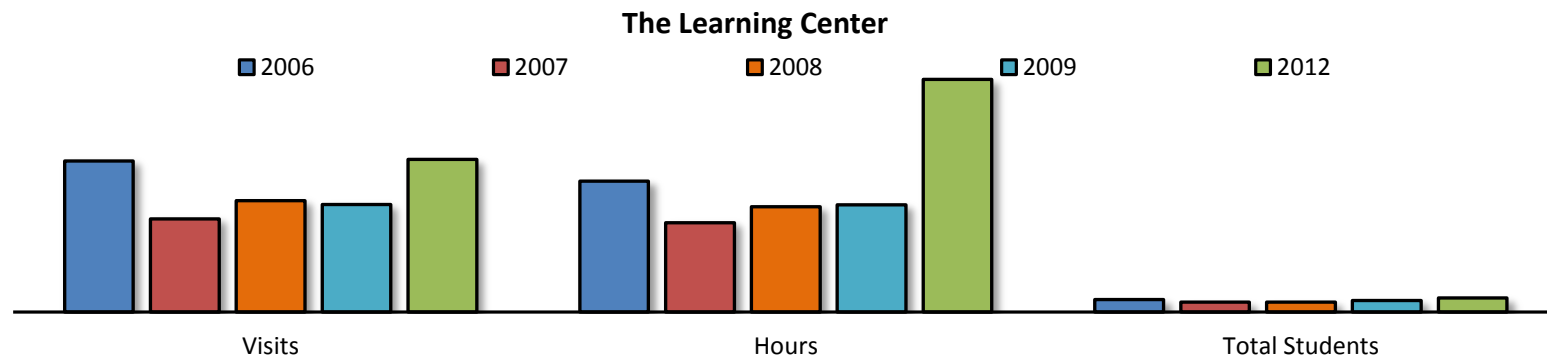
Visitors by Degree Type

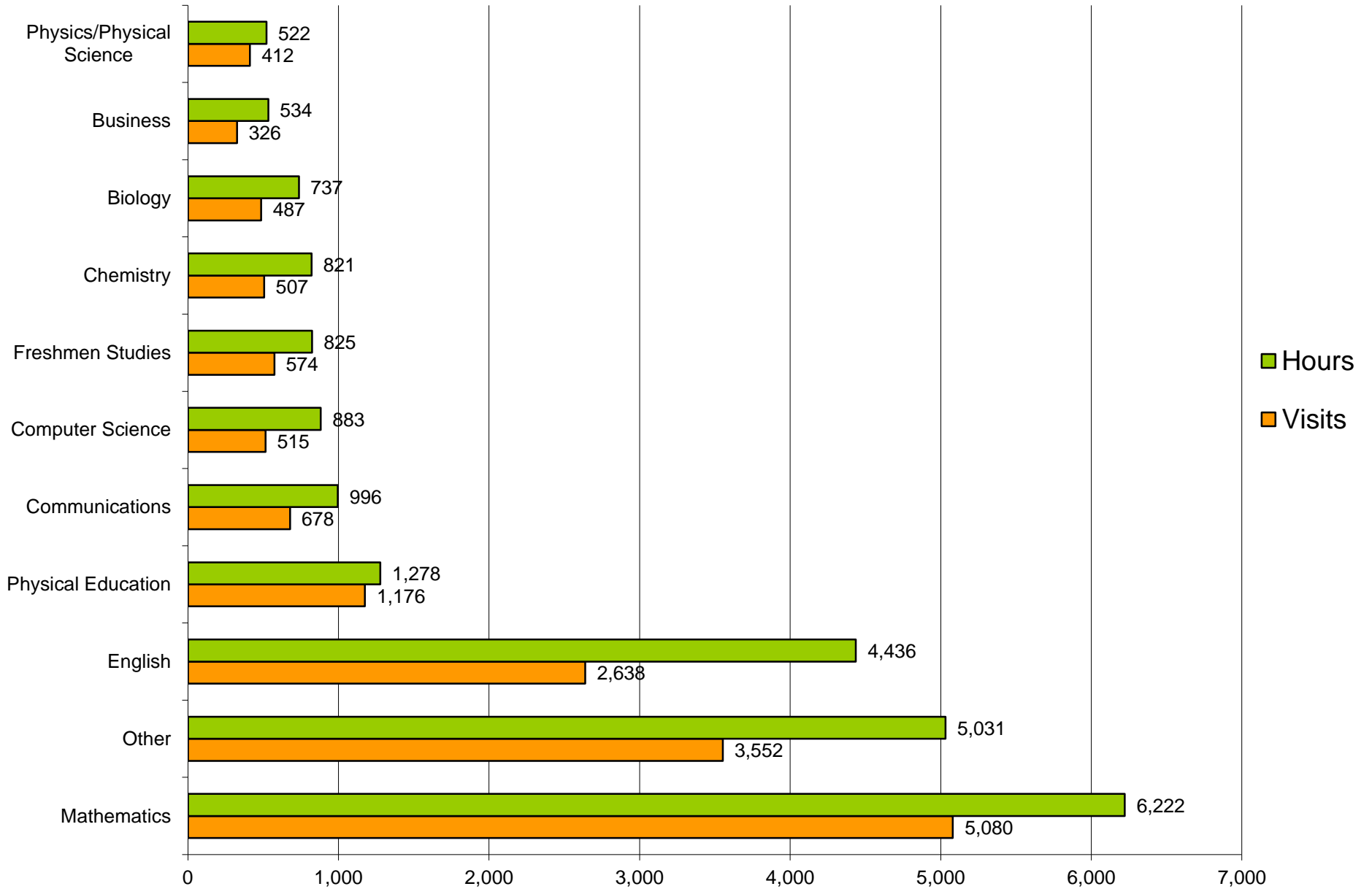
